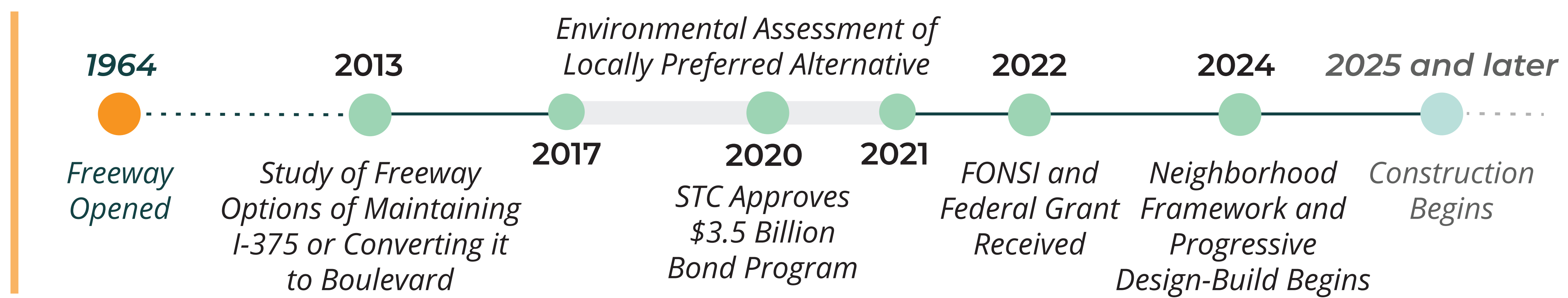


I-375 RECONNECTING COMMUNITIES PROJECT

How We Got Here...



Why Now?

This is a fully funded project as part of Gov. Whitmer's Rebuilding Michigan bond program and recipient of a federal INFRA grant that addresses outdated, crumbling infrastructure directly adjacent to downtown Detroit, Michigan's largest city.

Project Needs to be Addressed Include:

- A Aging Infrastructure**
Freeway infrastructure is more than 60 years old, and bridge and pavement conditions are deteriorating.
- B Congestion and Safety Concerns**
Congestion and safety issues due to growing traffic volume and inefficient left turning movements.
- C Outdated Freeway Design**
Freeway geometric and ramp design does not meet modern standards and leads to high crash rates.
- D Lack of Connectivity**
Lack of both vehicle and nonmotorized access and connections to local destinations along the freeway corridor.
